Scholarship criteria include enrollment in a construction management or related program, rising junior or senior, attending school full-time, a major GPA of at least 3.25, and an overall GPA of at least 3.0. Applicants are required to submit a letter of reference and a personal statement that addresses how the Retail Contractors Scholarship will enable them to achieve their goals, what sets them apart from their peers, their undergraduate academic goals, and their ideal career. Complete applications are reviewed and scored by the Scholarship Committee, comprised of Board members and Advisory Board members.

With so many unhealthy choices that children and grandchildren have today, Young Life offers a positive alternative. This organization helps children in all walks of life with many types of personal struggles. Royal Seal have been involved with Young Life for many years and knows of many instances when the organization made a life-saving difference in a child's life.

When the local **Children's Advocacy Center** wanted their first permanent location in Denton County, TX, Royal Seal did the renovation of an existing day-care center at no charge, using several nonviolent inmates in a partnership with the **Denton County Sherriff's Department** as labor for the demolition. This was a very rewarding project in so many ways.

The needs of the organization are so great and it is heart breaking to see what happens to children on a daily basis. According to the Denton County Children's Advocacy Center, "In the first six months of 2017, we have seen a 33% increase in child abuse investigations." The Royal Seal family continues to support the organization, both as a company and as individuals.

"As an organization and as individuals, Royal Seal knows that we are a small drop in the ocean, but with each drop we create ripples," said Gene Colley, President of Royal Seal and a past president of RCA. "We hope our example encourages others to become small drops in the ocean of giving back in life."
